## **BLUEBERRY SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENT TEST SUMMARY**

The chart on page 1 reports Parkland School Division student achievement on both Provincial Achievement Tests and Diploma Examinations. Individual subjects are provided in historical detail on the pages that follow.

Some considerations:

## Academic Achievements

Blueberry achieved at or above the Alberta Provincial average on the Grade 6 Provincial Achievement Tests in all subject areas at the Acceptable Standard (ELA 6, Math 6, Science 6, Social 6).

Scoring above the Alberta Provincial average on the Grade 9 Provincial Achievement Tests in all 4 subject areas at the Acceptable Standard (ELA 9, Math 9, Science 9, Social 9).

Scoring 15.2% higher than Alberta Provincial average on the Grade 9 Provincial Achievement Tests in Social Studies 9 at the Acceptable Standard.

81.55% of students writing the Provincial Achievement Tests in Grade 9 in 2016 met the acceptable standard. This significantly exceeds the provincial average of 70.3%.

## Area of Growth:

Scoring at the Standard of Excellence is a continued goal. The province exceeded Blueberry School in all subjects except Math 9.

2015-2016 PAT results were lower in many subject areas than scores in 2014-2015. We will look to analyze results and set goals for 2016-2017.
