



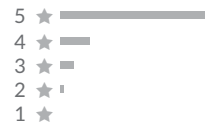

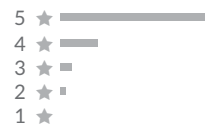
**The sidewalks and parking lot are a death trap. We need some work done and some sidewalks repaired. A better plan for drop off and pick up would be g Good too!**

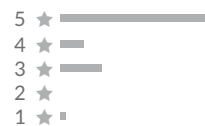
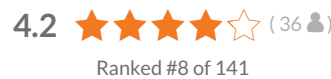
**Ice and drainage issues** Need a long term solution for drainage issues at the front of the school



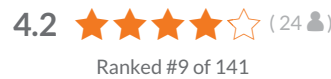

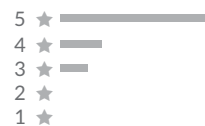

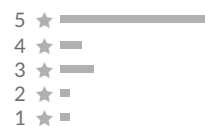

**Sidewalk and Parking lot safety** Year and years go by and no real solution are created.

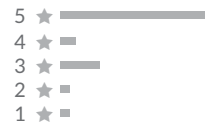

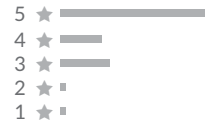
**A way to see the school** I understand with current pandemic restrictions it would require planning but we have never seen the inside of the school/classroom

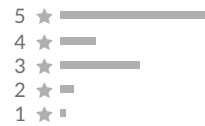
**Love the school and staff! They're all open and easy to communicate with. We need to address dangerous winter/spring sidewalks**

**I appreciate the teacher commitment and involvement they always go above and beyond. I have concerns with the administration level of things this year**

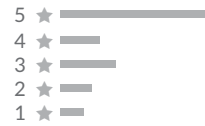
Communication home is huge right now with parents not being allowed in schools. I'm not feeling this is happening at an administration level.
