It provides parents and legal guardians online access to their children's progress in school. PowerSchool is accessible for students Grades 1-9 and teachers regularly post evidence of learning to keep families informed. General Information

Student Registration

Parkland School Division's annual online registration/verification process is coming soon. All Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 12 registrations for both new and returning students will be conducted online for the 2023-2024 school year. Returning PSD students will receive an email reminder to log into their PowerSchool Account and look for the RSVP button in the side navigation to launch the registration process. All parents are required to complete the registration process by 4:30pm on March 24, 2023. This deadline allows us to determine the eligibility of bus pass applicants, the routing of buses, bus pass production and data verification before the summer break while schools are still operating.

Important Registration Dates:

- Monday, Feb 13, 2023- Registration opens. The NewStudent Registration Form for Evergreen Catholic, area private school students and new to PSD students will be added as a Quick Link on the homepage of psd.ca. Families of returning PSD students (i.e. students currently enrolled in a PSD school) complete the registration process starting in PowerSchool.
- Friday, Mar 24, 2023 at 4:30pm- Registration deadline. For further information, visit our Registration page.
- Friday, June 23, 2023 Bus pass deadline to makepayment arrangements or pay-in-full.
- Bus passes and route numbers will be mailed to parents starting at the beginning of July.



Please note: The 2022-2023 New Student Registration form is still open and accepting registrations for the current school year. The 2022-2023 form cannot be used to register for 2023-2024. When registering, please make sure to select the correct school year in the drop down menu for the field 'Select School Year'.

IMPORTANT - PARKING LOT SAFETY! - Please read

Please be mindful of posted signs and avoid parking in the "no parking" drop off area. If you are dropping off your children, please go around to the drop off area (see BELOW), and then continue around the parking lot to exit. Please don't make u-turns at the entrance after you drop your children off. Our front parking lot goes in a "one-way" direction. Please be mindful of students and staff who are trying to cross the parking lot to get to and from the school, as it is now dark in the mornings and it's hard to see people walking. If you are parking to come in with your children, please use the far west side of the front (south) parking lot to park, after the designated staff parking spots (there is no parking in the drop-off area). The back parking lot (where the buses come in), is closed to vehicles while the buses are there (arrival and dismissal times). Also be mindful of the handicap parking stall by the gate.
We would also like to remind our community that parking three vehicles deep in the visitor parking is a safety concern. Please do not block vehicles during pick up time.

Student Absences

To ensure the safety of all of our students at Blueberry School, it is imperative that we are aware when they are absent from school. Facilities Update

Parkland School Division is announcing changes to their outreach and virtual learning programming, to take effect at the start of the 2023-2024 school year. This will in part affect Blueberry School, with one of our modular classrooms on the move to Spruce Grove to accommodate the changes.

One of our Kindergarten classrooms currently occupying that modular classroom will be moved to the flex space located in close proximity to the current Kindergarten area. PSD's Facilities Services staff will be making those improvements over the summer months, with some possible construction during Spring Break. The current Kindergarten class will**not** be impacted during this school year, as the modular will be removed over the summer.







The move will place PSD in a better position to request new funding and projects as PSD's overall utilization will increase.

The changes referenced above refer to an effort to centralize resources and support, and to bring programming offered by the Division's Connections for Learning (CFL) under one roof, PSD is relocating all outreach and virtual learning programming to the École Broxton Park School (EBPS) site, beginning in the fall of 2023 and they need a total of 5 modular classrooms to accommodate the incoming students. Currently, CFL operates junior and senior high outreach programming on two campuses, one in Stony Plain (located on Boulder Boulevard) and the other in Spruce Grove (located on St Matthews Avenue, near Wendy's). The move will eliminate the need to lease two separate buildings and allow staff to better support students in their specialized learning programs
