Student Absences

To ensure the safety of all of our students at Blueberry School, it is imperative that we are aware when they are absent from school. We ask that parents phone the school and leave a message on the attendance voicemail (Option 1) or email prior to 8:30 am to avoid the automated call out cut off at 8:45 am. School Fees

<u>School fees</u> are added to your child's Powerschool account. Fees can be paid with a credit card online through the PowerSchool Parent Portal at https://powerschool.psd.ca/public/home.html. You can also see any fees that are added, such as option fees, field trips as well as your account balance. Fees are posted to the website. Feel free to contact the office if you need further assistance.

Visiting Blueberry

To ensure our school day runs smoothly, we ask that you contact the office if you need to drop off a student after bell time in the morning. If a pick up is needed mid-day, parents/guardians can call the main office and the student will meet them there. All visitors are required to check in at the office.

Blueberry School provides a healthy, nutritious meal to our students through our hot lunch program.
