Timetable

We will be providing gluten-free pancakes for those who require, but if you have a student with another food allergy, please consider sending them an extra snack to enjoy with their classmates during this time. We will begin serving grade one classes and progress through the grades. Please encourage your child to eat breakfast as normal at home, as it may be later in the morning when they receive their pancakes.







Meet the Staff Night

We hope that you'll join us for our Meet the Staff night on Wednesday, September 25th from 4:30-6:30pm. Teachers will be explaining how to access Google Classroom, as well as some of the routines in the classrooms. Families with last names beginning A-M will visit classrooms from 5pm-5:30pm and families with last names N-Z will visit classrooms 5:30pm-6pm. Early Student Pick-Up

If you are picking up your child early from school please **phone the office** to let us know. Students are not allowed to leave the building without confirmation from a parent or guardian. Thank you for helping us keep your kids safe!

Student Absences

To ensure the safety of all of our students at Blueberry School, it is imperative that we are aware of when they are absent from school. We ask that parents phone the school and leave a message on the *attendance voicemail* (Option 1) or email prior to 8:30 am to avoid the automated call-out cut off at 8:45 am. **Please include your child's full name, homeroom/teacher, and reason for the absence.**

Administering Medication & Pre-Existing Medical Conditions

If your child requires medication during the school day, it is Division Policy that a signed consent form be completed. Contact the office. All medication brought to school must be kept at the office, and will only be accepted in the original clearly labeled bottle/box. Only prescription medication will be dispensed at the office. Please ask the pharmacist for a second labeled bottle to be kept at school if needed. All medication that was left at the school in June has been disposed of. Students who may need an Epi-Pen are required to supply an Epi-Pen for storage in the school office and the required forms must be completed. Please assist us in gathering all information regarding your child's pre-existing medical conditions.

Volunteers

We are so happy to be able to welcome volunteers back into our school. Stay tuned for messaging from your child's teacher for opportunities throughout the year. Please remember that a current Criminal Record Vunerable Sector Check must be on file at the school for anyone who volunteers more than ten hours in a school year. All volunteers and visitors must check in at the school office upon arrival.







Drop-Off & Pick-Up

Please note the following important information regarding **child safety** and parking at Blueberry School:

- 1. Reminder that there is NO PARKING in the drop-off areas in the morning from 7:40 8:00 am and from 2:20 2:50 pm daily.
- 2. Please be mindful of students and staff who are trying to cross the parking lot to get to and from the school.
- 3. Our front parking lot goes in a "one-way" direction. If you are dropping off your children, please go around to the drop-off area, and then continue around the parking lot to exit. Please do not make u-turns at the entrance after you drop your children off.
- 4. If you are parking to come in with your children, please use the far west side of the front (south) parking lot to park (there is no parking in the drop-off area).
- 5. The back parking lot (where the buses come in), is closed to vehicles while the buses are there (arrival and dismissal times).
- 6. Note that the parking stall by the gate is designated as accessible for those people who require it. It is not for general public use.
- 7. There is **no parking permitted in the North parking lot** during bus pick-up times (7:45 am 8:00 am and 2:45 pm 4:30 pm). Please do not park in the North parking lot to pick up students at the end of the school day as you will have to wait for buses to depart.









Entering and Exiting Blueberry

Students enter and exit the school through their designated doors. Exterior doors are locked during instructional hours. Students who arrive after 8:01 am are asked to enter through the main entrance.

Allergies

At our school, there are individuals with severe nut allergies. Consequently, we have processes in place to minimize the risk to these students. Whenever possible, please avoid sending nut products to school. We also have some severe allergies to scented products and ask that students and parents coming into the school refrain from using these products (perfumes, scented lotions, body sprays). Aerosol products are also not permitted in the school. Students are encouraged to bring underarm deodorant in a non-scented stick form. If your child has serious allergies, please ensure that the school is aware by contacting the office.

Counselling

We are pleased to welcome Mrs. Andrea Smith to Blueberry School as our counselor. Mrs. Smith will be at Blueberry School on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays.

Code of Conduct

Please take a moment to review <u>Blueberry's Student Code of Conduct</u> with your child. Classroom teachers have also highlighted this document with students during the first week of school.

Cell Phones/Smart Watches/Headphones

Students are asked to leave their cell phones in their lockers during instructional time. Grade 7-9 students are permitted to use their cell phones prior to school (before first bell) and during the lunch hour. Elementary students are not permitted use of cellphones during recess, to encourage active play. If you need to contact your child during the school day, please call the office to ensure all staff are aware of any student needs/concerns. Students are asked to come to the office to call home.

If devices such as smartwatches become a disruption to a student's learning, teachers will work with that individual. Headphones (such as airpods) should be left in lockers and not brought to class during instructional time. Students are encouraged to leave valuable items at home.

Orange Shirt Day

Orange Shirt Day is a legacy of the St. Joseph Mission residential school commemoration event held in Williams Lake, BC, Canada. It grew out of Phyllis' story of having her new orange shirt taken away on her first day of school at the Mission, and it has become an opportunity to keep the discussion on all aspects of residential schools happening annually. Please join us in wearing an orange shirt on Friday, September 30th as schools and communities come together in the spirit of reconciliation and hope for generations of children to come.
