Yearbook



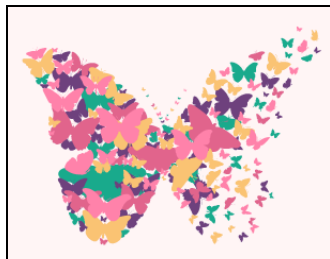
